Beach Clean-up SAFETY

COVID-19

- Recommended to wear a face covering if 6' social distancing can not be maintained
- Wash/sanitize hands often

Beach Clean-up Safety

- Don't turn your back on the ocean, watch for sneaker waves
- Wear a glove or use a trash picker to pick up trash
- *Look before you reach and grab
- Be careful with glass and sharp objects
- Do not lift items that are too heavy
- Beware of poison oak and ticks
- Leave dead animals (part of food chain)
- Wear sunscreen and stay hydrated
- Children must be supervised at all times

Notify the staff if you find:

- Syringes or hazardous materials Mark the Area, Do Not Pick-up
- Injured animals Do Not Touch
- Homeless Encampments Leave Areas Alone
